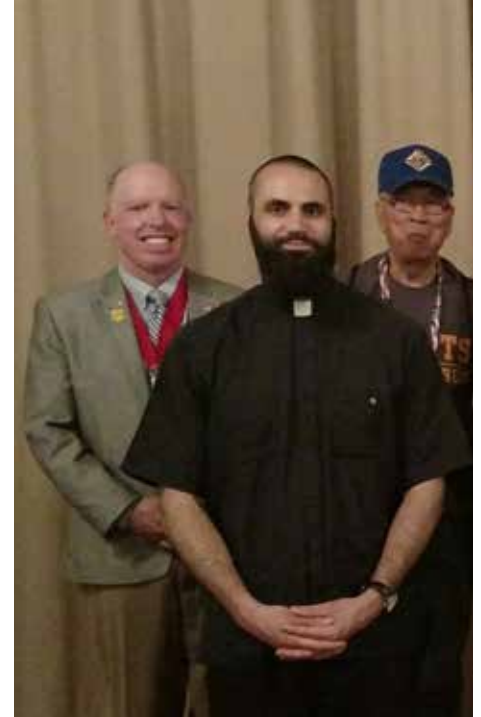

District Deputy Report:

Brothers, when we became Knights, we promised adherence to our principles of charity, unity and fraternity. With those principles we work, alongside others in our parishes and communities, in the hope that no person ever goes without the basic necessities, and that we aid our widows and orphans. But the Order can't do this alone. It continually needs new members to help strengthen parishes and communities. And we must let good Catholic men know

that we need them. It's a symbiotic relationship. We get new brothers committed to Father McGivney's cause. And they get a group of brothers to help them be more charitable, more spiritual, the center of faith within their families, and gain exclusive access to the protections offered by the KofC. While some men in your parish know the Order very well, others know very little — like the participants in your parishes' RCIA classes. They are still learning what it really means to be Catholic and what it means to be a Catholic man in today's world. Welcome them to the parish, perhaps by offering Catholic Information Service materials to the entire RCIA class and letting them know they are welcome to contact your council if they have any questions. Then, after they have been brought into full communion with the Church at Easter, welcome them to join you at a Knights of Columbus event.

Please continue to recruit- get men to their degrees, contact silent Knights, and ask men at your parish if anyone has ever asked them to join the Knights. State Convention is coming up and they still need to put together the Knights Got Talent program if you have any skills. Also don't forget to send in your delegate forms. However, every Knight is welcome to attend. They will be having an Admissions Degree Ceremony during the convention – May 18-20th, if you have any candidates around that time. Don't wait to bring them in. Next Admissions Degree is Tuesday the 14th at the Columbus Club. The KofC in San Diego have increased their service efforts to our Veterans. At the VA Hospital, only 5 Knights work the outreach program on a regular basis, but they are ALWAYS seeking more good men. Last year, over 200 hours were donated, 80% of from one Knight who does a lot of shuttle driving. The VA needs help in the following areas: Greeter, Administration, Driver, Moving wheelchairs, etc. Some work has scheduled hours, but most is not. If this sounds like something you'd like to do, contact the Program Chairman, John Carney
Need a Formation Degree Team. Not enough seconds. St. Pius does it every month now. 3rd Thursday.
Tootsie Roll Drive- hold it ASAP or send in the money. Don't mix ID Drive \$ with Council funds.
