Fisher House Foundation is best known for a network of 76 comfort homes where military and veterans' families can stay at no cost while a loved one is receiving treatment.

These homes are located near major military hospitals and VA centers, making it convenient for service men and women and their families who are in need of lodging close by. Fisher Houses have up to 21 suites, with private bedrooms and baths. Families share a common kitchen, laundry area, a warm dining room and an inviting living room. Fisher House Foundation ensures that there is never a lodging fee. Since inception, the program has saved military and veterans' families an estimated \$407 million in out of pocket costs for lodging and transportation.

There are three Fisher Houses in San Diego. One located at Camp Pendleton and two are located near the Na-

val Medical Center in Balboa Park.
